

## BEELINE – YOUR CHOICE . . . CHOOSE WISELY

BEELINE bus funding is provided by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT), under congestion management for the U.S. Route 202, Section 300 reconstruction project. The BEELINE provides an alternative to single-occupancy-vehicle commuting. Planning partners include the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), SEPTA and Chester County.

Companies are encouraged to support their workforce by:

- Making BEELINE passes available through payroll deduction. Qualified transportation fringe benefits, such as transit passes, can reduce tax withholding that saves money for companies and employees.
- Providing on-site information and expos about the BEELINE, the U.S. Route 202, Section 300 reconstruction project and other transportation alternatives.
- Working with the TMACC to provide customized commuting options for employees which can help with recruitment and retention.

If purchasing passes or ten-trip tickets by mail from the TMACC, you must include full payment by check or money order, along with a self-addressed, stamped envelope. Please mail requests for monthly passes by the 20th of the prior month to allow for processing.

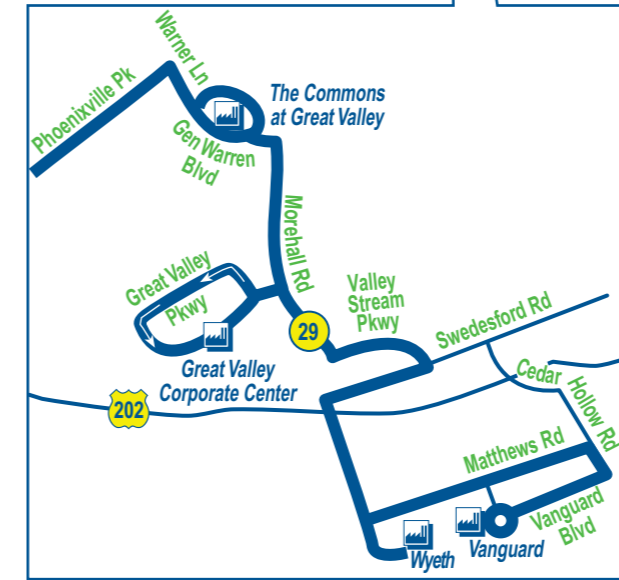
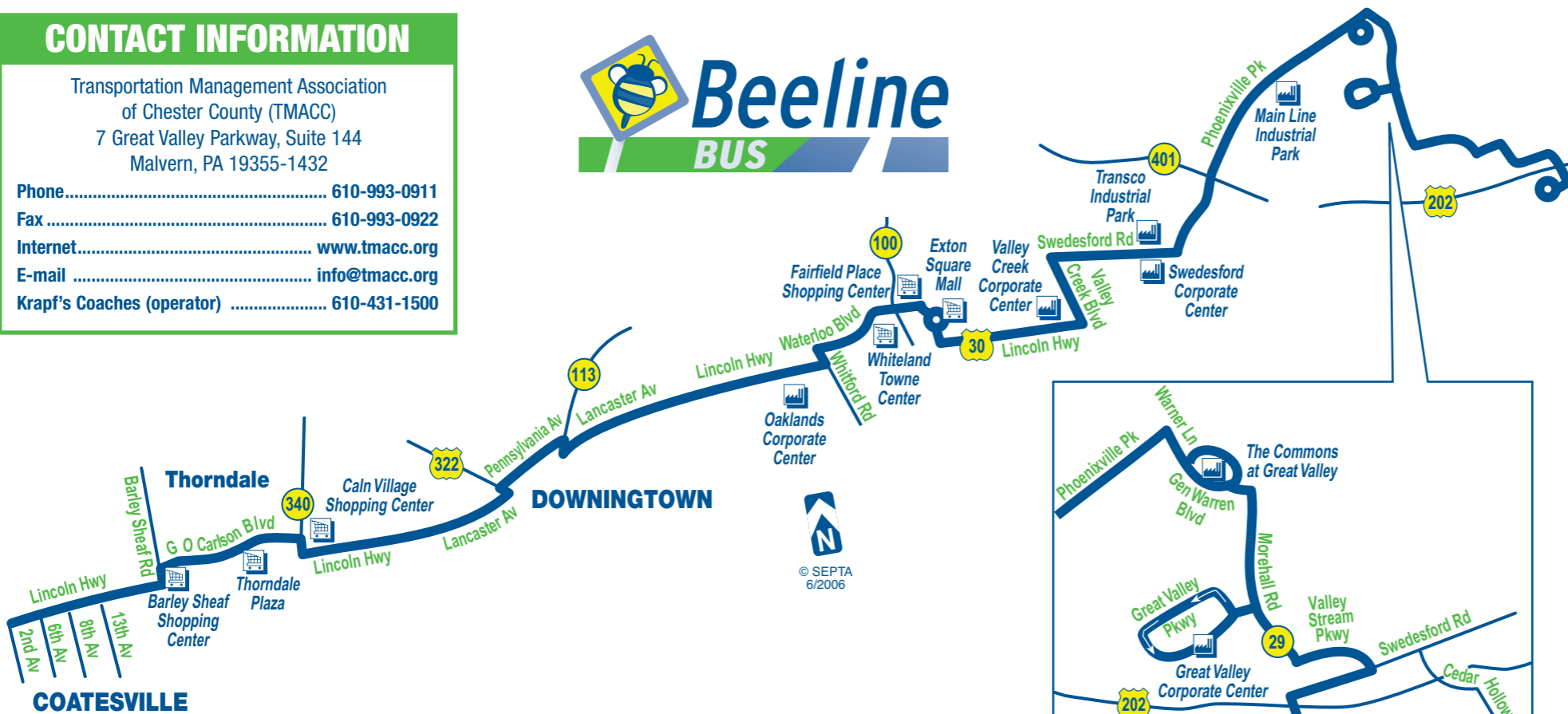

SEPTA fare instruments are not currently honored on this route.



**BEELINE** vehicles are equipped with wheelchair lifts. Please call TMACC at 610-993-0911 at least 24 hours in advance, during business hours (9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.) to confirm.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

No pets are allowed on **BEELINE** buses except guide dogs with their masters.

Persons conducting themselves in a disruptive manner, as determined by the driver, in consultation with a supervisor, will not be permitted to ride.

Service operates Monday through Friday only. No service will be provided on New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. In the event that these holidays fall on a weekend, no service will be available on the recognized national day of observance.

Schedules and fares are subject to change without notice.

If you wish to board in an area not clearly identified as a transit stop, please stand in a safe position, visible to the bus operator. Signal the operator as the vehicle approaches. They will stop at or near the area if deemed safe to do so. Requests for stop locations should be made in writing to the TMACC. Some stop requests may not be possible because of prior safety determinations.

The TMACC, its partners, contractors and contracting agencies cannot assume responsibility for inconvenience, expense or damages resulting from timetable errors, route delays, failure to make connections or for shortage of equipment.

Buses are operated by Krapf's Coaches, Inc. Immediate service issues can be directed to Krapf's dispatchers at (610) 431-1500.

**Weather Information:** The TMACC will provide information on major **BEELINE** delays or service cancellations, when caused by inclement weather or emergencies. Passengers should listen to WCOJ 1420 AM or check local television stations for information. The TMACC is not responsible for inconvenience caused by a broadcaster's failure to communicate information that it receives.

## ZONE BOUNDARIES

Effective January 7, 2008

Beeline buses operate on a three-zone fare structure. Trips that cross over one zone boundary cost an additional 60 cents; trips that cross over two zone boundaries cost an additional \$1.20. Fare boundaries are located at the following locations:

- Lancaster Avenue (Business U.S. Route 30) and Uwchlan Avenue (PA Route 113), Downingtown
- Swedesford Road at Exton Square Parkway, Exton
